Any Law School student or faculty member who has a reason to believe that a violation of the Honor Code has occurred shall, not later than within fifteen (15) school days after becoming aware of the occurrence, file a completed and signed Complaint with the Chief Prosecutor and the Assistant Dean of Student Affairs. For suspected violations occurring during the Law School summer session, the deadline for filing a Complaint is fifteen (15) days after the first day of the next Fall semester.
