The University cannot commit to keeping either a formal or informal Title IX discrimination complaint confidential because of the University's obligation to investigate the complaint, the University will use its best efforts not to disseminate information concerning the complaint beyond those who have a need to know.

TSU's Non-Discrimination Statement

It is the policy of Texas Southern University to provide a working environment that provides equal opportunity to all members of the University community. In accordance with federal and state law, the University prohibits unlawful discrimination, including harassment, on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, including sexual harassment, age, disability, citizenship, and veteran status in its programs, activities, admissions or employment policies.
