Select "Start a Filing" at the top of the page, then select:

1. Estate Planning (Power of Attorney, Advance Directive, HIPAA Release)

After completing those documents, go back to "Start a Filing" and select:

2. **Transfer on Death Deed** (to pass your home to your loved one without needing them to probate your estate).

You will be asked a set of questions to create your documents. Once you complete these documents, you should print them and bring them to the Wills Clinic.

You can protect your legacy through a transfer on death deed that passes your home to your loved one without needing them to probate your estate.
