The Immigration Law Clinic is operated as an in-house live-client clinic, which falls into conjunction with the Clinical Legal Studies Program.

OBJECTIVE:

Immigration Law Clinic is dedicated to giving its students an experiential learning experience. The objective of this program is to train students for real practice in the field of Immigration Law.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

This Immigration Law clinic presents students with an opportunity to acquire valuable and practical experience in the area of immigration law. The course assists in developing skills in the areas of client interviewing, investigative techniques, drafting of Immigration Law pleadings and forms, pre-trial motion practice, plea negotiations, courtroom presentation, and trial and oral advocacy skills. Students may be presented with the opportunity of a trial in the Immigration Law clinic as well. Students completing this course must demonstrate competency in handling cases from the initial client interview through court proceedings.
