One student presented from each law school to the ADR Section's Council will be awarded a scholarship in the amount of **\$1,000.00**.

Candidates to be considered for the scholarship should meet the following criteria:

- 2L Full-time student
- Demonstrate interest in the field of ADR through course work and other activities
- Demonstrate financial need
- Willingness to utilize scholarship funds on law school related expenses

- A completed 2020 Scholarship Application Form
- A current resume
- A short essay (*limited to 500 words*) expressing your interest in the field of ADR, activities you have engaged in related to ADR, and your career aspirations. Please feel free to add anything you consider relevant to your application for the award.
