### **Application Guidelines:**

- The applicant must be a **law student** in good standing with his or her school who has an interest in practicing aviation law.
- The applicant must be a **member of the State Bar of Texas Aviation Law Section**, or must fill out the attached application to be **automatically enrolled** for free.
- The applicant will submit a brief of **500 words or less** covering an **aviation case opinion** that was **decided in 2020 or 2021**.
- The brief must be submitted in **PDF form** via email to Caitlyn Goodwin ([cgoodwin@l-llp.com](mailto:cgoodwin@l-llp.com)) and Peter Busher ([pbusher@busherlaw.com](mailto:pbusher@busherlaw.com)) by **March 1, 2021**.
- Applications will be judged on the following criteria:
  - Technical writing skill, including compliance with the BlueBook and GreenBook;
  - Flow of narrative;
  - Accuracy of analysis;
  - Applicability of case selected to aviation law as a whole;
  - Interest in aviation law; and
  - Overall professionalism of the brief.
