**FOOTNOTES EXPLANATION**

Note 1: Student must be a rising 3L. Registration requires (1) a job application thru CoreELMS, (2) upload of copy of resume, transcript, and proof of offer letter into CoreELMS, and (3) upload of completed copies of executed MOU & application questionnaire on CoreELMS. Once your application is approved by Prof. Thomas, she will notify the registrar who will then issue a registration permit for you to complete your course registration. The the grading for the 4 credit hour externship is "Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory."

Note 2: This course must be taken concurrently with the related four (4) credit hour externship course with approval from the Law School Registrar.

Note 3: This course meets the writing requirement.

Note 4: To register for this course, student must be a rising 3L, have a full-time faculty advisor, completed application, and an attached "exhaustive outline" of the research paper.
