Note 2: This course must be taken concurrently with related externship course with approval from the Law School Registrar.

Note 4: To register for this course, student must have a full-time faculty advisor, complete an application, and attach an "exhaustive outline" for the paper.

Note 5: Student must have completed independent research 1 with a letter grade of B or higher to enroll in independent research II
