#### What do I do now that someone is out of jail?

#### a. Attend all the court dates.

i. You could lose your bond and they will be thrown back in jail.

#### b. Establish a reentry plan.

i. After being released you may need to reapply for any benefits you were receiving such as disability or SSN. go to https://www.houstontx.gov/education/reentry programs.html for a list of reentry programs in Harris County.

#### c. Clear your record.

- i. Certain criminal arrests can be cleared from your record.
  - 1. See if you are eligible by going to: https://clearyourrecordharriscounty.org/
  - 2. If you are eligible to have your record cleared sign up for one of the Clean Slate Clinics at the Earl Carl Institute. fill out an application

#### How to find someone in the Harris County Jail?

- a. Go to https://www.harriscountyso.org/JailInfo/FindS omeoneInJail
- b. Call 713-755-5300
- c. You will need the person's SPN

#### What is a System Person Number or SPN?

- i. This is the person's ID number in Harris county.
- ii. This will also allow to look up someone's next court date at <a href="https://www.hcdistrictclerk.com/edocs/public/search.aspx">https://www.hcdistrictclerk.com/edocs/public/search.aspx</a>
- iii. You can also find out the name of someone's attorney using the SPN number by going to <a href="https://www.hcdistrictclerk.com/edocs/public/search.aspx">https://www.hcdistrictclerk.com/edocs/public/search.aspx</a>

#### How can I contact someone in Harris County Jail?

#### a. In person

- i. Visitors must register via the online application before they are allowed to visit someone
- ii. After registering you will still need to schedule the visit seven days beforehand.

#### How can I contact someone (continued)

#### a. Through the Mail

- i. You will need to add the inmate's SPN and cell block to the letter.
  - 1. Cell blocks can be found in the same website you used to search for them.
- ii. Envelopes, stamps, pens, and medicine CANNOT be sent in the mail.

#### a. File a report with inmate care if:

- i. They need medical care.
- ii. They need mental health care.
- iii. The food service in poor quality
- iv. The cell in unsanitary
- v. You are being denied visitations.

#### How do I get someone out of jail?

#### a. Personal bond

- i. If a judge sets a personal bond an inmate will not have to pay and will be released with the condition to go to all the court dates.
- ii. Harris County has a bail docket and people are assigned bail attorneys
  - 1. It is important that you contact the assigned attorney at (713) 274-6700 so you can give them your story and they will give it to the judge.
  - 2. Many factors are considered when setting a bond so move fast!

### b. Surety Bond

- i. If a judge sets a surety bond, an amount of money must be paid or promised to get someone out of jail.
- ii. You can pay that in full via money order at 700 N. San Jacinto Street, Houston, TX 77002.
- iii. You can also use a bond company
  - Bond company's charge a fee for there services and those fees range.
     Call around before you decide on a bonding company.
