## **STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES**

This Immigration Law clinic presents students with an opportunity to acquire valuable and practical experience in the area of immigration law. The course assists in developing skills in the areas of client interviewing, investigative techniques, drafting of Immigration Law pleadings and forms, pre-trial motion practice, plea negotiations, courtroom presentation, and trial and oral advocacy skills. Students may be presented with the opportunity of a trial in the Immigration Law clinic as well. Students completing this course must demonstrate competency in handling cases from the initial client interview through court proceedings.

Finally, every student is required to meet with Professor Nguyen for an <u>exit interview</u>, which will serve as his or her final evaluation in the clinic.

Failure to comply with the policies above will result in dismissal from the Immigration Law Clinic Program and a drop from this course.
